Check this out: For sale, a Mata Ortiz pot made about 35 years ago by famous potter, Nicolas Quezada.

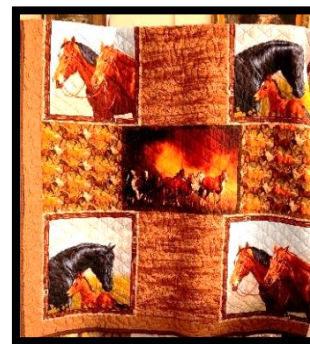


LITTLE GALLERY ARTIST OF THE MONTH

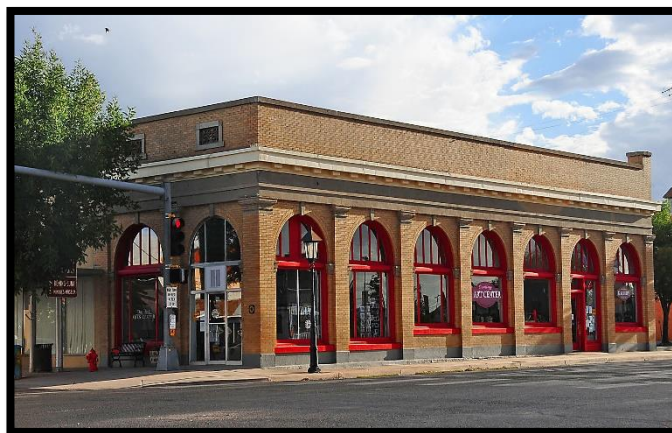
