#### OUR MISSION STATEMENT

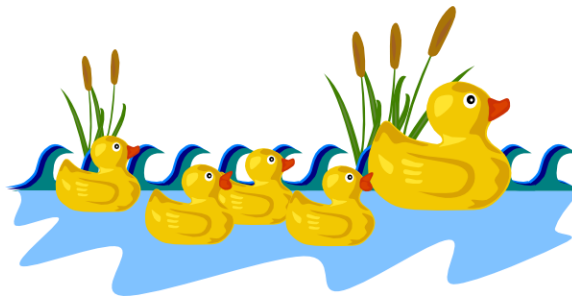
