Kit was an American author, philanthropist and social activist. She created the Sunflower Foundation, which provided financial support for organizations that work for Native American betterment, civil rights, peace, housing reform and environmental, labor and women's issues.

As an author and poet she published such works as "The Butterfly Rises", "The Guest in the Garden" and "Fragments: My Path Through the 20th Century".

One of her quotes is "Love is the universal answer no matter what the question, and that we must seek to manifest it in all possible ways."
