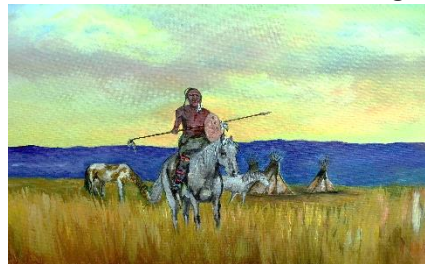
Various items will be available and proceeds will be used for projects at the Art Center.
