The most unusual show of the year! Art composed of every day items will amaze you at the September show. Per the Encyclopedia Britanica, Assemblage, in art, work produced by the incorporation of everyday objects into the composition. Although each non-art object, such as a piece of rope or newspaper, acquires aesthetic or symbolic meanings within the context of the whole work. The term Assemblage, as coined by the artist Jean Dubuffet in the 1950s may refer to both planar and three-dimensional construction.
